Appointment Checklist

In-Studio appointments are a great way to get one-on-one assistance with our Designers. During your consultation we can cover general design questions, help you get your project started, or advise on your design dilemma. Please see our checklist below to prepare for your visit:

CHECK LIST

✓ Your Current Space

Photos and a dimensioned floor plan of your existing space(s); these can be plans from your builder/contractor/kitchen designer/etc. or a quick hand sketch with rough measurements

✓ Inspiration and/or Wishlist

A few Inspirational images you've collected (Pinterest, Houzz, Magazines, etc.) of items & elements you'd like to incorporate into your space

✓ Finishes

Bring any samples and/ or photos of all finishes staying in the space (flooring, fabric, cabinetry, etc.)

✓ Paint

If you're not looking to repaint, please bring a chip and/or photo of the current paint colour(s)

✓ Samples

If you're looking for new finishes (flooring, counters, accent tile, etc.) it is best to bring options with you. We have very limited sampling in-store

QUESTIONS/TOPICS

Please make a list of questions/ topics you would like to cover during your consultation, this will help our designer prioritize and make the most of your in-studio appointment.

SOURCING

We typically only have time to source one item during an in-studio appointment. If you're looking for multiple items, additional design time & associated design fees may apply.
